In congratulating the Melbourne Bowling Club on its success in the competition, the Lord Mayor said that the bowling clubs in Victoria had about 12,000 members. The play in the competition matches had been of a high order, and it was certain that, if the proposal that a team of Australian bowlers should be sent to England next year was adopted, there would be plenty of first-class players from whom to select.
