Membership structure changing

The board is reviewing membership structure as a result of the discussions at the AGM. The board believes their needs to be a pathway for individuals who have experienced bowls through the barefoot bowls phenomenon and would like to become recreational bowlers. We believe a percentage of such a group would over time migrate to become competition bowlers for the club. A sub committee of **Chris O'meagher**, **Paul Gamble** and **Sean Ingram** are looking at how to best refine the constitution to allow for this pathway and maintain compliance with the licensing act and Bowls Victoria requirements. It is important that the end result remains true to our mission of being the leading competitive bowling club in Victoria. Any changes would require a change to the constitution which requires a special general meeting to be called. It is planned that this would occur this financial year.

RSA training

The board has agreed to sponsor up to 6 members to do the responsible serving of alcohol (RSA) training course. Once trained kate will take the member through the till process etc

Defibrillator (heart starter) training

Peter Curwen-Walker is intending to organise one of his colleague's to come along to train staff and interested members in how to use the defibrillator. There is a list up on the notice board and/or have a word to Peter. The training which will be a short session at the club is intended to be run most likely late August prior to the bowls season starting. Knowing how to use it might just save a mates life.
