Breaking News \$14,000 grant approved

We have just received verbal confirmation from Kelly O'Dwyer's electoral office that the Melbourne Bowling Club has received approval for a grant of \$14,000 to assist us in upgrading our kitchen. This grant will contribute to about 28% of the total upgrade. The kitchen was originally fitted out for our 100th celebration in 1964 and then minor updates were carried out in 1993.

The grant is as a result of the Federal Governments Stronger Communities Programme – Round 3 managed by the Department of Industry, Innovation and Science. Each electorate nominated applicants for the program. The MBC would like to thank Kelly O'Dwyer and her electoral office for initially alerting us to the grant and then approving our application to go forward to the Department of Industry, Innovation and Science for assessment.

We expect to have the paper work completed prior to Christmas and are intending to start the renovation, a complete refit, at the end of the current season likely to be mid April 2018.

A great example of our taxes at work at the local level. The upgraded kitchen will enable us to better service our members, social (barefoot) bowlers and community groups that use our facilities.
